Footnotes

GYPSY RING raced in midpack, chased four-wide late turn, gained command near led midstretch, bore out in the late stages but held, driving. COLD HARBOR raced off the pace, was hustled from the rail on the turn, rallied between rivals and bid in deep stretch but was outfinished. KID CANUCK raced midpack, chased into the stretch, angled out and rallied between horses. KING EDDIE, well back early, saved ground, closed into the stretch then rallied late between foes. ALWAYS WILDCATIN' raced off the pace, came four-wide through the turn, was all out upper stretch but evened out in the late stages. JET SET EXEC showed early speed, dropped back approaching the turn and stalked the pace, angled from the rail to three-wide nearing the top of the stretch but failed to sustain his bid and tired. PHILLY FRENZY forced the pace three-wide, bid late turn, dueled, was headed near midstretch and tired. SILVER ROCKET forced the pace, bid late turn, dueled into the stretch then tired in midstretch. CHILD O'MINE set a pressured pace, was engaged in earnest late turn, dueled into the stretch and tired.
