Footnotes

RESOLUTE BAY settled well back early, closed three and four-wide on the turn, finished full of run, got by late under a hand ride and finished in hand. EXPROPRIATE, off slowly, raced in range, closed on the turn, bid upper stretch, dueled, led briefly in deep stretch and was passed. JUSTIFY ME, used early, set a reserved pace, was joined upper stretch, dueled, then gave way grudgingly in the final 16th. SHUTTLECOCK raced off the pace, chased two and three-wide on the turn then finished gamely in vain. SLAMIN' DIXIE, in range, closed late backstretch, chased hard while three-wide on the turn but evened out in the late stages. TRACEY'S SMILE stalked the pace, chased two and three-wide on the turn then tired in the stretch. WEST SIDE GLORY raced off the pace, was hustled along the rail through the turn then tired in the stretch.
