HOLD THAT ECHO, off slowly, was unhurried to the far turn, circled seven-wide into the stretch, swept by the leader a furlong out and widened under a hand ride. TWILIGHT STORM raced in midpack, was hustled on the far turn, came six-wide into the stretch inside HOLD THAT ECHO and was outkicked. GROUP HUG settled in midpack, was hustled on the far turn, chased into the stretch, led briefly and was passed. RIVER SLANEY stalked the pace, closed three to five-wide on the far turn, bid near the 1/4 pole, dueled, but gave way upper stretch. SOY SAUCE settled off the pace, chased on the far turn and finished gamely but was never in contention. NASIRIYAH'S SONG raced off the pace, was hustled from the rail late turn then evened out in the stretch. ASKEATON stalked the pace, closed into the far turn and challenged the leader, took a short lead briefly but was engaged, dueled to the stretch and tired. SPANISH POST set a reserved pace, was headed early on the far turn, battled back but tired at the top of the stretch.
