Footnotes

LE CINQUIEME ESSAI dueled outside WANDO from the outset, wore him down inside the furlong marker and drew clear then held under a drive. DUMAANI STAR well back early, closed between foes late turn then rallied willingly. FRANK'S SELECTION stalked the duelers, began to close the gap on the turn, was in striking position a furlong out but hung. CONTROL TOWER raced well off the pace, came three-wide late turn under rousing, finished gamely but had too little too late. WANDO showed early foot, dueled from inside LE CINQUIEME ESSAI, held a very short advantage on the turn then yielded inside the furlong marker. PAT'S EXPECTATION stalked from the rail, was roused late turn but evened out in the stretch. FESTIVE SPIRIT raced midpack along the rail, closed mildly into the stretch but hung in the final furlong. RAW POWER was always well back and was pulled up at the top of the stretch.
