Footnotes

RINGBANG CITY had early speed, took a short lead into the turn, shook clear at the top of the stretch then just managed to hold under a drive. PYOTE raced off the pace, was blocked late turn, angled seven-wide then rallied willingly through the stretch. MY ANNA raced off the pace, was hustled late turn, angled six-wide late turn, was all out in the stretch but evened out late. AINT NO CURE raced off the pace, angled five-wide late turn, was blocked upper stretch, angled out and rallied gamely. SOMETIME ANYTIME, close early, chased two and three-wide on the turn then flattened out midstretch. DEVIL'S BLAST had brief speed, was hustled angling from three to five-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch then tired a sixteenth out. DANCING DAHLIA raced midpack, was hustled between rivals, was blocked late turn, rallied but evened out late. CRYING THE BLUES raced midpack, came three and four-wide through the turn, chased hard into the stretch but tired in the final sixteenth. VICTORIA CHARM raced off the pace, angled from four-wide to nine-wide on the turn but lacked the response to reach contention. KISSNRIDE raced midpack, saved ground, was in striking range at the top of the stretch but tired a sixteenth out. LA BONITA UNO had brief speed, dropped back on the backstretch then faded on the turn. SUNSET HEIGHTS held a short early lead, was headed at the turn, chased, but gave way late turn and was through.
