Footnotes

DAYLIGHT EXPRESS, rated off the early pace, closed four then five-wide on the far turn, challenged at the top of the stretch, dueled gamely and prevailed under a drive. ROYAL CHALLENGER, rated off the pace, was contentious on the backstretch, quickened on the far turn, bid at the top of the stretch, dueled to the end but was outfinished. BEARS TIGER led early under strong restraint, allowed rivals to close up early backstretch then quickened, set the pace still in reserve, was engaged at the top of the stretch and yielded quickly. RESERVOIR stalked the pace in range along the rail, launched her bid at the top of the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. SAFETY ZONE stalked the pace in range, was hustled between rivals late turn then evened out in the stretch. FAVORITE FANTASY, rated off the pace, was hustled from early on the far turn then had no response in the stretch.
