DINO DINARO raced midpack, closed three-wide late turn, rallied inside, gained command just into the final furlong then held under a drive. KENTUCKY JONES raced midpack, was hustled six-wide late turn, rallied gamely and gained steadily to the end. LANGFUHR COUNTRY stalked the pace, chased on the turn, bid upper stretch, duelled, was passed in the final furlong and gave way. ESSENCE THUNDER raced off the pace, chased between foes late turn then rallied willingly along the rail. FOREVER AWESOME raced midpack, closed into the far turn, took a clear lead, was engaged upper stretch and gave

way. AMA SOUL MAN raced midpack, was hustled five-wide late turn but never reached contention. RED RIVAL raced off the pace, chased into the stretch but did not threaten. MORETHANCONQUERORS broke in the air, raced well back, closed three-wide late turn then evened out in the stretch. PERSONAL SIGNAL stalked the pace, chased four and five-wide on the far turn then tired in the final furlong. PERFECT CREVASSE dueled, was passed early on the far turn, chased to the stretch and tired. NAFTA dueled to the far turn, was passed, chased to the stretch and tired. ROYAL RAGE raced off the pace, broke down at far turn and was pulled up.
