FOR TWO-YEAR-OLD COLTS AND GELDINGS, Sired by a Stallion standing in Ontario for his entire season the year of conception and registered with the Canadian Thoroughbred Horse Society for that season. **Footnotes**

BEAR'S PEAK stalked the pacesetter, chased five-wide into the stretch, gained steadily and got up late under a drive. ALTIUS forced the pace, took the lead into the turn, set a pressured pace then failed to contain the winner near the wire. QUINTANA, in range along the rail, chased hard into the stretch but evened out in the late stages. CITIUS, well back early, was roused late turn then finished gamely along the inside. CHARLIE BULL raced off the pace, closed four and five-wide on the turn, was offered steady encouragement but lacked a strong response and did not threaten. QUARTERBACK broke alertly, was hustled angling from four to six-wide on the turn then evened out in the stretch. EXPLOSIVE'S BEST, in range between horses, chased five-wide late turn but lacked a strong closing response. MOLINARO HANDSOME led early, was headed at the turn, forced the issue to the stretch and tired. CALIUS raced off the pace, saved ground, angled three-wide late turn but did not menace. WHO BY FIRE settled well back early, trailed the field and had no late response.
