Footnotes

BOWMANSTON stalked the early leader RIVER SALT from just off the rail, drew even outside of that one midway through the turn and assumed command entering the stretch, then drew clear under steady pressure. BOLD TIGRESS was allowed to settle just off the rail, roused three wide on the turn and got up for place. RIVER SALT broke sharply and sprinted to the early lead, moved to the rail and was unchallenged, but gave way in upper stretch and dropped back. BOUREE was void of early speed, roused in the three path on the turn and finished with a mild rally. CAUGHT FIRE settled in the second flight along the rail, but lacked a late response and was never a factor. RUBY TANGO was close up between horses, then tired in the stretch and dropped back. FIVES ARE WILD broke slowly then rushed to condition along the rail, then faded on the turn.
