SAFETY ZONE led early, was joined at the front midway of the backstretch, quickened late turn then drew off in the stretch, widening when asked but finishing under a hand ride. SAFE LANDING stalked from the rail, chased into the stretch and finished all out. DUBAI GOLD saved ground, was hustled into the stretch and finished with good energy. PELLEGRINO (BRZ) joined the leader midway of the backstretch, dueled on the turn, was headed late turn and gave way grudgingly in the stretch. GET RICH QUICK raced in range but on the fringes, chased into the stretch and evened out late. IT'S LIKE THIS raced off the pace, chased four-wide on the turn, was up close at the top of the stretch, was all out to the late stages then evened out. NEAR NOISE raced off the pace, chased late turn, launched his bid at the top of the stretch, failed to get up and tired. KESAGAMI broke slightly outward, stalked the pacesetters three-wide, failed with an all out bid upper stretch and tired.
