Footnotes

NASIRIYAH'S SONG, rated early, chased four-wide to six-wide on the turn, rallied and swept by the leader just into the final furlong and held sway under a hand ride. SPANISH DEPUTY stalked the pace in hand, was roused two-wide late turn then rallied gamely. ANDTHE SKIPPER TOO set a pressured pace, dueled on the turn, led upper stretch, was passed just into the final furlong, chased briefly and evened out. SOARING HEART, rated off the pace, closed into the turn, raced five-wide, was all out upper stretch then evened out. CASH IS IN THE BOX stalked then forced the pace late backstretch, dueled inside rivals on the turn, gave way grudgingly upper stretch and tired a furlong out. HARLEM PRINCESS stalked then pace, forced the issue from between rivals on the turn, chased four-wide into the stretch and tired. GYPSY SAGE showed early speed, broke an inside line on the backstretch and was pulled up.
