PATRIOTICANDPROUD stalked the pace three-wide, bid four-wide late turn, was headed at the top of the stretch but rebid quickly, gained a narrow advantage, was engaged in deep stretch but prevailed at the wire. STUNNING STAG, rated in range, stalked from the rail on the far turn, launched a furious rally in the stretch, drew even in the late stages and just missed. RIVER RUSH ducked out early, settled in range in hand, chased five-wide into the stretch and closed determinedly. PERFECT AFLEET showed early speed, was headed early backstretch and forced the pace, bid into the far turn, dueled, led upper stretch but was engaged and gave way grudgingly. STUNNING SPLIT, in range between rivals, stalked the duel on the turn, chased into the stretch but evened out in the late stages. HEAD HONCHO raced off the pace, was roused early on the far turn, chased four-wide into the stretch, was all out but evened out in the late stages. LORD OF GREATNESS forced the pace, gained a short lead on the backstretch, dueled on the turn, was headed at the top of the stretch, chased to midstretch and tired.
