PLAYERS CLUB, rated well back early, chased late turn, rallied between horses and got by the leader in the late stages under a hand ride. SHIRLEY STREET stalked the pace, bid along the rail late turn, shook clear at the top of the stretch but failed to hold the winner safe. JALOUZI, off a step slowly, closed along the rail on the backstretch and turn then finished all out. LIVADA chased from between horses in striking range, was roused three-wide at the top of the stretch but evened out. YES IT'S RED dueled briefly and moved clear crossing the gap, set a pressured pace late backstretch and drew clear, was caught late turn and headed at the top of the stretch, chased briefly and tired. SAMANTHA ROYALE showed brief speed, bobbed crossing the gap causing her rider to loose her outside iron but recovered quickly, moved up and forced the issue to the turn then backed away and lacked a closing response. SENSE GOLD settled off the early pace, was hustled from midpack on the turn but tired in the final furlong.
