ECSTATIC, off a step slowly, settled off the pace, closed four-wide on the far turn, bid late turn, drove clear upper stretch and held under steady handling. DARUMA'S DREAM, in touch, was hustled on the far turn, chased into the stretch then finished all out. TULITA stalked the pace, chased into the far turn, bid late turn, was headed at the top of the stretch but finished gamely. GOLD PLAY settled off the pace, closed three and four-wide on the far turn then finished determinedly in vain. BANK ON IT, in touch, chased four-wide on the far turn, challenged late turn, was headed at the top of the stretch and evened out. HIDDEN TURN, off a step slowly, pressed the pace, backed away from between rivals on the far turn and was through. SCREAMED PINACH led quickly, set a pressured pace, was engaged late turn, hustled into the stretch and tired.
