DELEGATION, jostled at the start, sprinted clear and set a reserved pace, was set down at the top of the stretch and held sway under a drive. CITY WOLF stalked the pace, was hustled three-wide late turn and finished with a strong rally but ran out of real estate. JAMES STREET settled off the pace, chased four-wide on the far turn and finished willingly. ALPHA BETTOR, rated off the pace, was in range on the far turn and finished under a determined drive. VERTIFORMER stalked the pace, chased hard late turn but evened out in the stretch. MOBILIZER, jostled at the start, settled in midpack, chased four-wide late turn then flattened out with a furlong to run.
