TEN FORWARD was allowed to settle in the four path, roused around the turn, angled in mid stretch and got up in the final strides. VISALIA DUST pressed the pace outside of MY MAGIC PENNY, assumed command at the 1/4 pole and drew clear in upper stretch, just failed. POONAMALIE was hustled along chasing the leaders, lacked a late response and ran evenly. PORTS CREATION was off slowly and unhurried early, saved ground around the turn, finished with a mild bid. CHINA NIGHTS was void of early speed, never rallied and was never a threat. LADY ACCADIA was hustled along in the early going outside of PORTS CREATION, never rallied. BOOSTIN HOUSTON, bumped at the start, was void of early speed on the inside, no factor. MY MAGIC PENNY was rushed to the lead from the inside, faltered in the turn and faded stretch.
