Footnotes

PORT MARIA was rushed to the early lead and set a pressured pace along the rail, held a length lead to the stretch, then held off A LOT LOUDER in an all out drive. The latter was in hand between horses, closed the gap on the turn and loomed boldly entering the stretch, but hung in the drive. GOLD LINED stalked the early pace inside of rivals, angled outside of the leaders midway through the turn, but failed to respond. SHEKOTICHE was unhurried early just off the rail, roused inside of rivals on the turn, but was never a threat. BLUE SKY LADY was slow early off the rail, roused between horses on the turn and finished with a mild rally racing four wide. SAN BON WAY was hustled along outside of rivals, then dropped back on the turn. KARAN'S BID pressed the early pace three wide, then tired in the stretch and dropped back. QUEEN'S BELIEVER raced close up three wide, then faded in the stretch. SECRET OOGA BOOGA was void of early speed off the rail and never rallied.
