Footnotes

BELLE OF THE NILE stalked the pace, bid at the top of the stretch, moved clear and widened under a drive then was taken in hand nearing the wire. BLUES DANCING pressed the pace, challenged at the top of the stretch but was outkicked. SILENT FOREST led early, set a pressured pace, quickened on the turn but was caught near the top of the stretch and tired. GILDED GENAROSE, well back early, was hustled three-wide on the turn but never reached contention. SILENT PASSION, in range, dropped back late turn and finished evenly. OFFLEE BOSSY stalked the pace, faded along the rail on the turn then lacked a closing response. SUNDAY MONDAY settled midpack, was hustled three-wide on the turn then tired in the stretch. IRISH SONGSTER, always well off the pace, lacked rally.
