Footnotes

HARD NOT TO LIKE stalked the pace, bid four-wide late turn, dueled into the stretch, moved clear midstretch and widened under light handling. HAMPSTEAD HEATH showed brief speed then stalked the leader from the rail, bid along the inside late turn, dueled, then yielded midstretch. JOMELO raced in midpack, closed five-wide into the stretch, finished gamely but did not threaten. CAMPITELLO stalked the pace along the rail then finished evenly without bidding. COLLEEN'S SAILOR raced in midpack, was hustled four-wide late turn but never reached contention. MAKING AMENDS, rated off the pace, saved ground but lacked a closing response. STORMY REVENGE sprinted to a clear lead on the backstretch, set a reserved pace, was engaged late turn, dueled briefly and tired at the top of the stretch. ALDOUS SNOW, rated in range, altered course to avoid a rival in distress and pulled up shortly after. SECRET CONSULTANT broke down early on the backstretch while dueling.
