HOPER led quickly, vied briefly and moved clear early turn, drew off then held under a steady drive. MAYARRO bobbled leaving, remained patient and unhurried, closed five-wide late turn and finished determinedly, getting to the winner late. RUSHING ROSE, well back early, swung out midturn, closed four-wide and finished gamely. SAPPORO, well back early, closed four-wide late turn then evened out. SUPER WOMAN, well back early, closed four-wide late turn and never reached contention. AAANND LOVING IT raced midpack three-deep, lacked a rally. MI'AN MAR was hustled along four-wide on the turn then evened out in the stretch. AUNT ANNIE forced the pace, was hustled after the leader on the turn then tired in the stretch. CUTE OPERATOR stalked the pace, dropped back three-deep on the turn and had no late response. CRAFTY ANGEL raced midpack between foes, lacked a rally. NANCY BROWN

dueled on the backstretch, gave way early turn and faded.
