DON DULCE, rated in midpack, chased three-wide late turn, launched a determined charge in the stretch and was up just in time. CHARLIE'S THE MAN, prominent early, dueled two-wide on the backstretch and far turn, stayed gamely to the end and was caught in the final yards. ENDURING STAR had speed, dueled from the rail, was still very game in the stretch but was caught in the final strides. EXETER ROAD settled off the pace, chased four and five-wide on the far turn then rallied outside. CLEAN HOUSE stalked the pace, chased through the stretch and was game to the wire. PIT ALLEY raced off the pace in hand, came three to five-wide through the far turn then rallied willingly. BEAR'S TENOR raced in midpack, came four and five-wide through the far turn, chased into the stretch, lost his path midstretch then evened out. CAPTAIN CANUCK raced in midpack, was hustled three-wide on the far turn but was never a threat. DARK CLOUD DANCER settled off the pace, closed into the far turn, stalked along the rail then tired in the final furlong.
