VICE N' FRIENDLY was in hand just off the rail, assumed command in the turn and drew clear under a hand ride. ONE WAY LOVE was in hand between horses, saved ground through the turn and finished with a mild rally but was no match for the winner. MR. EPPERSON was hustled along four wide pressing the early pace, stayed wide in the turn and weakened in the late going. LAH KONOC was void of early speed off the rail, roused along the rail in the turn, angled out for the stretch run and finished with a mild rally three wide. MERKABAN was in hand between horses but failed to respond and ran evenly. SOUTHERN BOSTONION vied for the early lead outside of rivals but dropped back in the turn and faded. GORDY'S OUR MAN was shuffled back at the start and allowed to settle off the rail, roused in the turn but never rallied. UNCLE WOGER was hustled along between horses then dropped back in the turn in a dull effort. GRECIAN'S REBEL was hustled along between horses and close up in the backstretch then dropped back around the turn.
