HOTEP stalked the pace in hand, came four-wide into the stretch, moved to the rail, launched a determined drive and got up late under a drive. VICAR STREET, in touch, angled three to five-wide through the far turn, was all out in the stretch and just missed. WALDHEIM led from early backstretch, quickened late turn then gave way grudgingly in deep stretch. BIG TIME broke a step slowly, raced off the pace, rallied six-wide and finished gamely in vain. SPIRIT FLYING broke in the air, raced well back, was hustled on the far turn then evened out late inside. LARVIN forced the issue on the backstretch, came three and four-wide through the far turn then tired at the top of the stretch. PERSONAL SIGNAL led briefly, was headed entering the backstretch, forced the issue from the rail, gave way on the far turn then tired in the stretch.
