Footnotes

AUTEUR, in touch, bid six-wide late turn, was headed at the top of the stretch, rebid upper stretch and prevailed under a drive. LIFES NOT A BREEZE led on the first turn, set the pace, quickened on the far turn, led upper stretch, was engaged a furlong out, dueled to the end and just missed. RED LEADER was used a bit in the early stages, settled, raced four and five-wide through the turn, was hustled into the stretch, finished gamely and was gaining late. GENIUS KINSHASA raced midpack, closed along the rail late backstretch, chased on the turn and finished gamely. BRITISH BANKER raced midpack, came three and four-wide through the turn, was hustled into the stretch and tendered a mild rally between foes. FAVORITE SOUP raced off the pace, saved ground, was blocked at the top of the stretch then lacked a rally when clear. PIT ALLEY raced off the pace, was blocked upper stretch then lacked a rally between foes. BULLONTHEWIRE, well back early, closed seven and eight-wide late turn and never reached contention. MEDIDOCIHOSPISURG, in touch early, was up close approaching the turn, lapped on to the leader, was roused late turn then tired in the stretch. BAG OF HAMMERS raced off the pace,

came five and six-wide through the turn, chased but evened out late. COOL HAND DUKE raced off the pace, angled from three to six-wide on the turn then lacked a rally. MESA CIELO, in range early, was blocked at the top of the stretch and failed to menace. CAPTAIN MARK stalked the pace, forced the issue on the turn, was cleared at the top of the stretch and tired.
