RUNAWAY CONTENDER pressed the pace, bid into the far turn, dueled, shook clear at the top of the stretch then was all out to hold. LOOKS PURRRFECT, squeezed back just out, closed on the backstretch, chased three to five-wide on the the turn, was under an all out drive and was gaining in deep stretch. JINX BUSTER, in range, was hustled four and five-wide on the far turn then chased determinedly through the stretch. CAPTAIN CASUAL, well back early, closed between rivals on the far turn then evened out in deep stretch. VICAR STREET settled in midpack, was hustled two-wide on the far turn

then evened out in the late stages. GOTTA BE SMOOTH settled off the pace, chased five-wide on the far turn but never reached contention. EVAC, well back early, chased hard five-wide on the far turn but never reached contention. DUBAI ECHO, in range, closed into the far turn, bid four-wide midturn but failed to sustain the drive. RAYNHAM, well back early, angled out chasing late turn and never reached contention. EL GRAYLING set a pressured pace, was joined at the far turn, dueled, but tired at the top of the stretch. CUVARA, off badly resulting the rider losing an iron, raced well back, closed on the backstretch but tired on the far turn. FIRST RATE stalked the pace to the far turn and faded.
