SUMMER WEST, in touch between rivals, was in tight and in hand late turn, chased into the stretch and swept by the pacesetter then held under a drive. QUEENSTOWN, away a step slowly, settled off the pace, circled six-wide late turn then rallied gamely. TOURIST RESORT settled off the pace, was hustled three and four-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch and finished gamely. WHINNY POOH settled off the pace, closing six-wide on the turn, came extremely wide into the stretch but finished willingly. OLD COOKSVILLE challenged for the leader early backstretch, moved clear into the turn, set the pace was passed a 16th out and gave way. KRZ EXECUTIVE, close early, chased on the turn then evened out along the rail in the stretch. WHITEWATER MIST moved up to challenge for the lead on the main track, dueled, was headed at the turn, chased to the stretch then tired in the final furlong. BEST OF THE BELLES, prominent early, settled and stalked the duel, chased on the turn but tired upper stretch. FRIENDLYPERSUASION stalked the pace, chased four-wide on the turn, chased hard into the stretch and tired.
