Footnotes

FOXY CONNECTION was allowed to settle inside of rivals, saved ground on the turn and found her best stride in deep stretch getting up in the final strides outside of a tiring DEMALOOTPHOTOSHOOT. RUBY TANGO was void of early speed along the rail, roused between horses on the turn and closed willingly four wide. DEMALOOTPHOTOSHOOT was hustled along inside of rivals, assumed command entering the stretch and opened a clear lead, but stopped in the final seventy yards. EARLY RUCKUS was hustled along outside of rivals, assumed command on the turn, but weakened in the drive. SLOT HAPPY was away alertly and hustled along between horses then tired in the stretch. DAYTIME DRAMA was shuffled back at the start, then rushed to contention from off the rail, could not sustain that effort and weakened in the drive. YOU'VE GOT MAIL was void of early speed outside of rivals and never rallied. FINAL COVENANT was hustled along vying for the early lead well off the rail, then tired in the stretch. DEAR TOBIE was off slowly and trailed throughout.
