Footnotes

ONCE SILVER closed ground rapidly after breaking a bit slowly, opened a clear lead on the turn and was much the best under a hand ride in the drive. COMEDY AT THE MET was hustled along inside of rivals, angled off the rail entering the stretch and was second best. NATIONOFLITIGATION was void of early speed between horses, saved ground on the turn and finished well. NO CHEATING was allowed to settle just off the rail, roused four wide on the turn and finished with a mild rally. STORMY CAMPAIGN was hustled along close up in the backstretch, but lacked a late response. WISE ENDING was unhurried early off the rail and lacked a late response. ROBYN'S SWEETEE was hustled along pressing the early pace, then tired and dropped back. COURT PAPERS was hustled along in the middle of the pack, then dropped back on the turn. FLASHY N' SHEIKH was away alertly and hustled along outside of rivals, then faded in the stretch.
