TACKY AFFAIR was hustled along vying for the early lead from between horses, battled gamely into the stretch and drew clear in the final furlong under steady pressure. CAVALIER BILLIE was hustled along pressing the early lead three wide, dropped back slightly entering the stretch and got up for place. POLISHED STONE was allowed to settle between horses, roused four wide on the turn and finished with a mild rally. LOVELY QUEEN was hustled along pressing the early pace inside of rivals, ran gamely to deep stretch before weakening. THE DALLAS DANCER was shuffled back and allowed to settle just off the rail, roused along the rail on the turn and made a mild bid, but was never a threat. FAUX PAS was void of early speed, roused four wide on the turn but was never a factor. WEREWOOFY was hustled along three wide and never rallied. AUGURI SHARDAE was allowed to settle widest, raced six wide on the turn and never rallied. ISAWTHELIGHT showed brief speed inside of rivals, then dropped back on the turn.
