

LUNA BLU, close early, chased three and four-wide on the turn then evened out in deep stretch. BUBBLES TO THE TOP stalked the pace, was hustled on the turn, chased into the stretch then evened out in the late stages. REFUGIO raced in midpack, closed along the rail late turn, loomed up at the top of the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. STRANGER THINGS raced in midpack, angled three to six-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch then flattened out. MOUNTAIN ECHO, prominent early, backed away late backstretch and lacked a rally. ACHIEVING, off slowly, raced well back, was hustled through the turn but lacked a closing response.
