ANDROEAH settled off the pace, closed between rivals on the far turn, challenged a furlong out and drove clear. PERFECT AGILITY settled off the early pace, was hustled on the far turn, was six-wide approaching the top of the stretch and finished under an all out drive. BENITA BLUE, in range, forced the pace into the far turn, chased four-wide into the stretch, failed with a bid upper stretch and chased to the end. KEERA settled off the pace, steadied slightly along the rail at the far turn, chased late turn from between rivals, angled out in the stretch and finished gamely. LONESOME TOWN settled off the pace, was hustled five-wide late turn then evened out in deep stretch. CHEDINGTON, away slowly, settled off the pace, was set at the down at the top of the stretch and finished gamely in vain. QUINTE WEST raced in midpack two-wide, chased into the stretch and finished gamely to no avail. WELL EXECUTED, in range, was in the thick of the action in the first tier late turn, was roused at the top of the stretch but flattened out with a 16th to run. LIGHT VELVET, in range, chased hard on the far turn then tired in the final furlong. READY TO RAMBLE stalked early, pressed the pace early on the far turn, chased into the stretch then flattened out. INCLUSA, in touch, bid midway through the far turn, dueled, gained the lead at the top of the stretch but was quickly headed and

tired. CITRINATION led early, set the pace, dueled from midway of the far turn, was headed at the top of the stretch, chased briefly and tired. BELLA VICTORIA raced in midpack, chased into the stretch and tired.
