COURTVILLE, away a step slowly, settled off the pace, was hustled angling from three-wide to the rail on the turn, responded smartly and swept to the lead upper stretch and held under a drive. SEELEY'S BAY, off slowly, raced in midpack between rivals, was hustled four-wide and was closing late turn then finished all out. WONDER PHIL raced in midpack, chased five-wide closing late turn and finished gamely. KHULNA, off alertly, was quickly headed and

stalked the pace, was hustled three and four-wide on the turn, challenged at the top of the stretch, dueled briefly and was passed then chased, but evened out in the late stages. UNCATCHABLE FIRE settled off the pace, was hustled on the turn, chased two-wide into the stretch and closed late along the rail. ULTIMATE DESTINY raced in midpack, chased hard three-wide on the turn then finished determinedly between foes. EXECUTIVE CLUB stalked the pace, was set down two-wide at the top of the stretch, chased, but evened out in the late stages. FLIM FLAM settled off the pace, was hustled three to five-wide through the turn but never reached contention. JIMMY CHEW SHOOS raced off the pace, was hustled four to six-wide through the turn then evened out in deep stretch. BEAR AND ROD stalked the pace, chased two and three-wide on the turn, lodged his bid at the top of the stretch, dueled briefly and tired a furlong out. MIA'S ROCKET led onto the main track, set the pace, was swarmed at the top of the stretch, battled, but tired a furlong out. STRANGRTHANFICTION, in range, chased four then three wide on the turn then flattened out in the stretch. MARKED IN STONE, in range on the backstretch, dropped back early turn, chased to the stretch and tired.
