FLYING ECHO moved up to duel on the main track, vied along the rail, drove clear upper stretch and held sway under steady pressure. SILENT YET DEADLY, bumped at the start, settled off the pace, chased three and four-wide on the turn and finished under a determined drive. ETHANOL, bumped at the start, stalked the pace, chased hard late turn and was all out through the stretch. EXECUTIVE SHOPPER raced in midpack, closed four-wide on the turn then finished gamely outside. SUNNY WEATHER raced in midpack, chased from the top of the stretch but was blocked in the late stages. MACHITO raced in midpack along the rail, chased into the stretch and finished evenly. SPARROWHAWK stalked the pace, backed away a bit on the turn then finished evenly between foes. OUR FRANCHISE, squeezed back at the start, settled off the pace, saved ground then rallied late along the rail. HARTE TO HARTE settled off the pace, trailed four-wide on the turn then finished gamely in vain. MOUNT DIABLO settled in midpack, was hustled three to five-wide on the turn then evened out in the stretch. CANUSPELLPATIENCE, bumped at the outside, led early, was joined on the main track, dueled, yielded upper stretch and

tired. RUVEE stalked the pace, chased hard three-wide late turn then flattened out in the stretch. CELTIC SPIRIT, bumped at the start, settled off the pace, chased hard three to five-wide on the turn then tired in the stretch.
