QUASAR POWER settled in midpack, chased five-wide late turn, rallied and got by late, driving. CAJUN KISS led early on the backstretch, set a pressured pace then was passed in deep stretch. VICTORY MAST stalked the pace, chased into the stretch and finished gamely. INDIAN GUIDE away slowly, settled off the pace, saved ground and closed on the turn, angled out in the stretch and rallied gamely. PERFECTLY MARKED, in touch, chased four-wide late turn then finished gamely between foes. LAFONTAINE showed early speed then pressed the pace, chased two-wide into the stretch then gave way grudgingly. OCANERA stalked the pace, chased four-wide into the stretch then evened out in the late stages. SPEIGHTSONG stalked the pace, came two and three-wide through the turn then evened out in the stretch. ASCOT MARTIN settled off the pace, was hustled three to five-wide on the turn but never reached contention. RUMBLE TIME, off slowly, raced in midpack, chased four-wide late turn then evened out in the stretch.
