Footnotes

CAPE RACE settle din midpack, angled out late turn but was steadied slightly, rallied five-wide and got by late under a hand ride. GOOD ANSWER, always close to the pacesetter, bid early turn, dueled and wore down STOLICHO late turn, was joined at the top of the stretch, dueled all out through the stretch and was passed late but held place. NEVER STOP LOOKING raced off the pace, chased angling sharply from the rail to four-wide late turn, bid upper stretch, dueled but gave way grudgingly in the late stages. ROCKY ROMANO settled off the pace, was hustled four and five-wide on the turn then chased through the stretch. CHASING BRIDGET stalked the pace, was hustled four-wide late turn but was not a threat. STOLICHO, sent to the early lead, set the pace, dueled on the turn, gave way nearing the top of the stretch and tired. MONEY'S WORTH stalked the pace, was steadied three-wide late turn, chased into the stretch and evened out.
