Footnotes

UPKEEP led early, set a reserved pace, was pressured on the far turn, was clear and widened through the stretch then was taken in hand nearing the wire. ESCAPE ARTIST settled off the pace, chased hard two-wide on the far turn then rallied along the rail. EYE OF THE WORLD, squeezed back just out, raced off the pace, closed angling from the rail to four-wide on the far turn, cut back to the inside upper stretch and rallied along the rail. WILL HE WON'T HE stalked the pace, chased two to four-wide on the far turn, was game in the stretch but evened out in the late stages. LIME DROP KID settled off the pace, chased four and five-wide on the far turn but never reached contention. STORMY REVENGE stalked the pace, chased up close three-wide on the far turn then tired in the final furlong. SAN CRISTO stalked the pace, was hustled three and four-wide on the turn then flattened out in the final furlong. MOJUMBO, off slowly then bobbed, raced off the pace, was hustled five and six-wide on the far turn then evened out in the stretch. FORT MORGAN raced in midpack, was hustled two-wide on the far turn then tired in the stretch. CANADIAN FLAG raced in midpack, chased three-wide through the turn then tired in the stretch. HALLAM settled off the pace, was hustled along the rail on the far turn then also tired.
