**Footnotes**

PASSAGE ROAD, well back early, was hustled along between foes late turn, angled out upper stretch, rallied gamely and just up, driving. MARDEN HILL raced midpack, was sent after the leader nearing the far turn, was patient around midturn letting GRAB THE CAT and JUST FINE duel, bid three-wide upper stretch, shook clear, but failed to contain the winner at the wire. RUSHING ROSE stalked three-wide, angled in upper stretch and rallied gamely inside. DANISH FAIRYTALE (DEN), unhurried early, closed four-wide on the turn then hung in the stretch. GRAB THE CAT led quickly, set a reserved pace, dueling from midturn then tired in the final furlong. JUST FINE raced midpack, closed fast three-wide early turn, bid midturn, dueling into the stretch then tired in the final furlong. WISHBONE KID stalked the pace, faded along the rail from early on the far turn. CLEARLY A. K. O. stalked, was under a ride on the far turn but faded. RALLA, always off the pace, was hustled along three-wide but lacked a response.
