ATLANTIC KEY vied from midway of the backstretch, dashed clear early turn, widened under a drive then finished under a hand ride. SETTLE THE SCORE, off badly, closed on the backstretch, was hustled between foes late turn and finished gamely. MR. TURNABOUT raced off the pace, closed from well back on the turn, came six-wide to the top of the stretch then evened out in the late stages. PAYTON'S VICTORY raced in the middle of the pack, came four and five-wide through the turn and launched an all out stretch drive. HALF TWIST raced off the pace, came four and five-wide through the turn then showed a mild late run between rivals. GAMBERONI, off slowly, closed into the turn, was roused three-wide at the top of the stretch then tired a 16th out. VICAR'S VISION raced off the pace, was three-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch but never reached contention. SET IN STONE raced off the pace, was hustled between foes late turn, chased into the stretch then evened out late. STRIKE OR SPARE raced off the pace, saved ground then lacked a late

response. BLIND RESPECT vied from midway of the backstretch, was headed early turn, chased, then tired in the stretch. JIMMY THE JESTER raced off the pace, angled three to six-wide on the turn then lacked a rally. HASTIE BREAKER led early, vied from midbackstretch, was headed early turn and faded along the rail.
