ZHIVAGO, well back to the final turn, closed three and four-wide, rallied gamely and was up late under a hand ride. CAREER HIGH, always contentious, led under pressure on the final turn, shook clear into the stretch but was caught late. JAMES STREET, always prominent, dueled on the backstretch then forced the pace through the final turn, finished all out and was still game and close up at the finish. KHABIBULIN stalked the pace, chased on the last turn but flattened out in the stretch. TIR CHONAILL was contentious if not prominent to the final turn, backed away, chased under a ride but had no stretch response. DZINGISKAN raced off the pace, was hustled on the last turn but lacked a closing response. AT ISSUE stalked the pace early, was hustled through the final turn and tired.
