VELVET SNOW unhurried early, closed four-wide late turn, gained steadily through the stretch and just got up. TAMARA stalked the pace from outside CAVALIER BILLIE, closed late turn, challenged outside SWIFT OF FLIGHT at the top of the stretch, drove clear and had command to deep stretch but failed to contain the winner. CAVALIER BILLIE stalked the pace from the rail and finished evenly. PIPERS TRICK well back early on the rail, moved onto the second path late turn then lacked the necessary stretch response. DAYTIME GIRL (IRE) raced off the pace on the second path, moved to the rail late turn but lacked a strong closing response. SWIFT OF FLIGHT sprinted to a long early lead, set a reserved pace through the turn but was through at the top of the stretch.
