Footnotes

FOREST JUSTICE led early, was joined in a duel early backstretch, vied to the stretch, continued to battle and came up with a strong late effort and prevailed under a drive. KODIAK MOMENT moved up to stalk the pace late backstretch, bid four-wide late turn, dueled to the end but was outfinished. SILVER ROCK raced off the pace, chased four-wide on the turn then finished gamely. EVEN stalked the pace, bid three-wide late turn, dueled into the stretch, yielded a sixteenth out and tired. TRUE STRIKE raced off the pace, was hustled two and three-wide on the turn then evened out in the late stages. GORDON BENNETT stalked the pace, was hustled late turn then tired at the top of the stretch. CHURCHONSUNDAY broke sharply but outward, moved up and dueled on the backstretch and turn but tired at the top of the stretch.
