LADY'S FIRST CAT, in touch, closed five-wide late turn, lodged his bid at the top of the stretch, dueled and prevailed under a drive. ARROW'S CONQUEST raced off the pace, closed five and six-wide on the far turn, bid at the top of the stretch, dueled, but gave way grudgingly in the late stages. TAZZ raced well back, closed inside rivals on the backstretch, bid from the rail at the top of the stretch, was no match for the top two but finished all out. RED LEADER was used early then settled off the pace, closed late backstretch, was hustled angling from three to five-wide on the turn, chased in the stretch but failed to menace. TRUE METROPOLITAN led early, set a reserved pace, was engaged at the top of the stretch and tired. PRECURSOR stalked the pace, chased four-wide on the far turn then tired at the top of the stretch.
