HOSANNAH'S SONG sprinted to the early lead, set a reserved pace, quickened late turn then held sway under steady handling through the stretch. HIGHLAND FLARE, in range, closed three-wide late turn and chased through the stretch. SOLAR BLESSING raced off the pace, was hustled angling from four to six-wide on the turn then finished all out. MISS MCDREAMY, in range early, chased five-wide late turn and was coaxed along through the stretch. NOT A LADY raced off the pace, was hustled four-wide on the turn then evened out in the stretch. MARY VERONICA was in range early then settled off the pace, chased two-wide late turn but evened out in the stretch. PRINCESS AMDALA stalked the pace, chased three and four-wide on the turn then flattened out in the final furlong.
