**Footnotes**

ULTIMATE DESTINY forced the pace, bid early turn, dueled, shook clear in the final furlong and held under a drive. MIA'S ROCKET stalked the pace, bid late turn, dueled into the stretch, was headed a furlong out and chased to the wire. BAT OUT OF HADES, in touch, stalked the pace on the turn, chased four-wide into the stretch and finished gamely. FLYING ECHO, bothered at the start, was hustled four-wide from off the pace on the turn then finished gamely in vain. SHE GAVE ME LIFE, rated off the pace, was hustled five and six-wide on the turn then finished all out outside the field. GOTTANICERINGTOIT broke inward, settled in midpack, chased four-wide late turn then evened out in deep stretch. KILI raced in midpack, chased four-wide on the turn, launched an all out drive, angled inward and finished along the rail. PERSPECTIVE, rated off the pace, was hustled on the turn but never reached contention. NO MORE RINGS set a pressured pace, dueled on the turn then tired at the top of the stretch. DESTIND TO PAY settled in midpack, chased hard on the turn then tired in the stretch. FLASH CRASH, off poorly, raced well off the pace and lacked a rally.
