ATHENA ROSE dueled briefly then took a short lead late backstretch, set a pressured pace, shook clear at the top of the stretch and widened under a drive. AMBITIOUS JOURNEY raced in midpack, closed along the rail late turn and launched an all out drive in the stretch. COPENHAGEN COWGIRL bumped sharply with a rival at the start, raced well back then was all out along the rail in the stretch. HENNY BLUES stalked early then settled midpack on the turn, showed a mild stretch response but was not a threat. FAIRY FAMILIAR dueled briefly then forced the pace, was cleared at the top of the stretch, chased to the final furlong and tired. CLEOPATRA'S FINEST, well back early, chased two and three-wide on the turn but never reached contention. MY SILVER QUEEN, bumped at the start, raced well back along the rail and lacked a rally. HILDEGARDE raced well off the pace, came three and four-wide through the turn then lacked a closing response.
