TURNER'S HALL was well rated pressing the early pace, assumed command in upper stretch and opened a clear lead, weakened in the final strides and just lasted. MISS SWEEP was bumped at the start and dropped well off the lead, rallied four wide on the turn and closed willingly in the drive getting up in the final strides. MARISA GO stalked the early pace three wide, roused on the turn, but flattened out in the drive. ETERNALLY YOURS was in hand between horses, steadied at the quarter pole and weakened along the rail in the drive. EBONY COUNTESS was void of early speed, roused between horses on the turn, but failed to respond. NORTHBOUND SALLY was void of early speed while saving ground, roused on the turn, but was never a threat. FRIENDLY PIONEER pressed the early pace inside of rivals, then ran into FOXY DEVIL, who was being pulled up at the quarter pole, was then eased in the drive. FOXY DEVIL set a pressured pace inside of rivals, then broke down at the quarter pole and pulled up.
