PADRAIG dropped back early, closed angling from two to six-wide through the turn, rallied gamely, bid midstretch and drove clear. SHADES OF GOLD raced midpack, chased hard late turn, rallied, bid midstretch but was outfinished. PERSECUTE raced off the pace, angled from four to seven-wide on the turn, was hustled into the stretch and gave a strong late effort. HAVING SAID THAT, in range, closed four-wide late turn, chased through the stretch but did not bid. REGAL RING raced off the pace, circled angling from five-wide to eight-wide on the turn, rallied outside but evened out late. FOREST FOUNTAIN stalked the pace, lodged an inside bid late turn, drove clear at the top of the stretch, was caught a 16th out and tired. SILKEN MANNER raced off the pace,

was hustled three-wide on the turn then evened out in the stretch. BOLD ALPHIE pressed the pace, bid three-wide midturn, dueled, was headed at the top of the stretch, chased, but tired late. DUENDECILLO raced midpack, chased hard late turn then flattened out in deep stretch. RIDGEWAY raced off the pace, chased hard five-wide late turn then evened out in the stretch. BANKER LARRY raced off the pace, was roused five-wide midturn but never reached contention. ROCKIN ON TOP raced midpack, saved ground but lacked a rally. CHIEF EXECUTIVE led early, was engaged midturn, dueled, was headed leaving the turn, chased into the stretch and tired. LOVER BOY raced midpack, was hustled hard late turn then tired in the stretch.
