A supplemental nomination may be made no later than the time of final entry, by a non-refundable fee of \$2,000, which includes the entry fee. Footnotes

HOTEP led quickly, set a reserved pace from well off the rail, quickened into the far turn, was engaged past midturn and headed at the top of the stretch, rebid near the furlong marker and moved clear under light handling. STORMY LORD stalked the pace, tried to challenge inside the leader at the far turn but was unable to match strides, took another run at HOTEP past midturn, gained a clear lead angling out leaving the turn, was engaged by that one near the furlong marker but was no match while still best of the others. RILEY RIPASSO stalked the pace, was hustled four-wide late turn, rallied gamely but failed to menace. COGNASHENE, rated off the pace, chased hard on the far turn, was determined in the stretch but failed to show a gain. ARCHON, in touch early, closed on the backstretch, was roused late turn but flattened out in the final furlong.
