MISS LAYLA, rated off the pace, angled out closing late on the far turn, rallied gamely and swept by the duelers a 16th out, driving. POINT OF EMMINENCE stalked the pace in hand, bid three-wide late on the far turn, dueled, was passed midstretch and held the place. ARIEL'S BAY raced in midpack, was hustled on the far turn, bid along the rail approaching the stretch, vied then gave way grudgingly. SILENT PASSION, off slowly, raced off the pace, was hustled four-wide on the far turn, bid late turn but lost ground at the top of the stretch then evened out. LARBOARD LADY set a reserved pace, was caught late turn and gave way at the top of the stretch. BROULAN stalked the pace, backed away under a ride on the far turn and was through.
