VENOM raced off the pace, closed angling from two-wide to six-wide on the turn, bid midstretch and wore down the leader under a drive. GULCH KNIGHT raced off the pace, closed angling from three-wide to five-wide on the turn, took command a furlong out then was all out but failed to hold the winner safe in deep stretch. BLU THEM AWAY, off a step slowly, closed from the rail to three-wide on the turn and continued to gain steadily through the stretch. WOULD IF I COULD dueled from the early stages, was passed a furlong out then continued on with the earlier duel giving way grudgingly through the final furlong. PIZZA LOVER dueled, was passed a furlong out and also gave way grudgingly. BOLD SUSPECT raced midpack, chased angling from four to six-wide through the turn then evened out in the late stages. MORANI raced off the pace, angled from two-wide to eight-wide closing on the turn but never reached

contention. ENCROACHMENT raced off the pace, angled from four to six-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch then evened out. CANDY GAMES raced midpack, chased two-wide on the turn, was all out upper stretch but evened out. SADDLE CREEK raced midpack from the outside, chased five and six-wide on the turn then lacked a stretch response. MERCADO was hustled along the rail in range on the backstretch, backed away on the turn and tired. HOME IN TWO dwelt, broke outward, trailed the field and was eased.
